♦ **The National Program for the supply in Drinking Water (PN-AEP) By 2016 – 2030**

To ensure universal access of populations to drinking water service in accordance with the Human Rights Approach (AFDH)

♦ **The National Program for Sewage and excreta sanitation (PN-AEUE):**

To ensure sustainable sanitation of sewage and excreta, to eradicate outdoor defecation. (DAL)

♦ **The reform of the management system of Hydraulic structures for drinking water supply in rural and semi-urban areas:**

To respond to the challenges of the reforms concerning the control of the concept of public service, its legislative and regulatory aspects, the management of the contracting authority by the local authorities, the emergence of the private and associative sector, the regulation of the service, the satisfaction of the customers of these public services, the delegation of public services in the form of affermage.



CEMEAU History

1990 : Creation of the CFP for ONEA agents' training.

2007: Launching the transformation process of the CFP into a water profession center.

2008 : Setting up of a CEMEAU project team with the mission of operationalizing the strategy of transforming the CFP into a CEMEAU.

2009 : Adoption of the transformation of the CFP into CEMEAU and creation of a department of the water profession center attached to the General Management of ONEA.

2010 : Progressive setting up of the different departments of the CEMEAU and opening of the Center to all the national and sub-regional actors.
